[The Big Move](#), Metrolinx's Regional Transportation Plan for the Greater Toronto and Hamilton Area (GTHA) identifies a system of 51 connected [mobility hubs](#) at major transit stations as one of

the nine "Big Moves" that will have the most transformational impact on the GTHA's transportation system. These mobility hubs are to be places that provide travellers with seamless access to the regional transit system, support higher density development, and demonstrate excellence in customer service.



what

Metrolinx have created [Mobility Hub Guidelines](#) to support the planning and development of mobility hubs. The Guidelines:

- Clearly communicate the mobility hub concept.
- Provide guidance for mobility hub and station planning and development across GTHA, using helpful precedent photos, diagrams, and case studies to illustrate the strategies and approaches.
- Guide Metrolinx in planning efforts, infrastructure design, and facilities in mobility hubs.

Metrolinx is offering a free training workshop on the Guidelines for members of the Institute of Transportation Engineers and the Ontario Traffic Council.

why

The Guidelines have been unanimously approved by the Metrolinx Board of Directors, who has also directed staff to apply them to major new transit investments, not just mobility hubs.
