Downtown TTC Streetcar Tour, Wednesday, June 16, 2010 7:15 p.m.

On Wednesday, June 16, 2010, the Toronto Section will be hosting an evening downtown streetcar tour with the tour taking place on one of TTC's historic PCC cars. TTC historian Scott Haskill will be leading the tour and Tim Lawson will add some background about transit signal priority in the City.
